Increasing Complexity and Interdependence

- Many Components. These include opensource libraries, third-party APIs, and cloud services. Each component introduces potential vulnerabilities.
- Interconnected Systems. A vulnerability in one part of the supply chain can affect many systems. This interdependence means a single weak link may cause widespread issues.

• Continuous Integration and Deployment. Securing the CI/CD pipeline is crucial to prevent the introduction of malicious code.

Rise of Cyber Threats

- Targeted Attacks. Attackers infiltrate trusted software to gain access to wider networks.
- Sophisticated Techniques. These include advanced malware, zero-day exploits, and social engineering. A robust security posture is necessary to defend against these threats.
- Financial and Reputational Damage. Companies may face regulatory fines, legal costs, and loss of customer trust. Recovering from a breach can be a lengthy and expensive process.

Regulatory Requirements

- Compliance Standards. These include regulations like GDPR, HIPAA, the Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification (CMMC) and the FTC Safeguards Rule.
- Vendor Risk Management. Companies must ensure that their suppliers adhere to security best practices. A secure supply chain involves verifying that all partners meet compliance standards.
- Data Protection. Securing the supply chain helps protect sensitive data from unauthorized access. This is especially important for industries like finance and healthcare.

Ensuring Business Continuity

- Threat Monitoring. Use tools like intrusion detection systems (IDS) as well as Security Information and Event Management (SIEM) systems.
- Education. Awareness and training help ensure that everyone understands their role in maintaining security and threat awareness.

A breach or outage can have severe consequences. Securing your software supply chain is no longer optional; investing in this is crucial for the resilience of any business and its longevity.

Have you ever found yourself working at the desktop and thinking... There has got to be a better way of doing this! Well, if you are aware of some keyboard shortcuts, you may have your questions answered.

If you are documenting a process for your office and need to capture an image or do a screen grab, you can use the key combination of **■ + Shift +S** to *marquee* (designate a top corner and diagonally opposing bottom corner to highlight/select a screen section on a computer) and copy it to the computer's clipboard. Once an item is selected, you can then paste it into a document, PDF, jpeg or presentation as you like.

If you frequently use your clipboard, you may start up the Clipboard History and access it by using the key combination of **H** + **V**. Once you start it with

this combo, you will get a prompt to have it run by clicking the "Turn on" button in the Clipboard history. Look at the top of the Clipboard History and you will see some icons that link you to the extensive array of options this tool delivers to the user. You may get icons, gifs, images, symbols, emojis and other fun and useful items many of us use to communicate. As you use it, you may select clipboard items

to pin (for future use) or you may delete them from the history if you won't need them later. If you use emojis, some Microsoft apps, Publisher for NOTE: It is best to read this column while at your computer for a better understanding of the content presented. Enjoy!

example, may not display or print properly when you insert them. Word, however, appears to work fine with them.

Should you fancy peppering your messages with emojis, then you may use 🖪 +; as the keyboard combination to call them up. Again, the same rules may apply if working in Publisher, since they are the same "characters" used in both situations. We have also found the ## + . combination delivers the same result (emojis).

If you are working in a browser, simply press the CTRL + T for a new Tab. In a similar fashion, you may also press CTRL+ SHIFT + T to reopen a closed window. Many of the CTRL keyboard shortcuts use the SHIFT to "reverse" what has been done with the <special key> + <Letter> command. Another example is the Show Desktop

> keyboard command of **#** + **D**. If you have applications open and the desktop is not visible, simply press the ⊞+D. Once you have found or opened what you wanted on the desktop, you may restore the apps by using **≇** + **SHIFT** + **D** to revisit your open applications as they were. Then, if you need to switch between the open applications, use the key combination of **ALT** + **TAB** to cycle through them all on one screen OR

depress the same two keys ALT+TAB plus SHIFT to reverse the selection order in the same screen. We hope this helps you to work more efficiently.
